POSITION TITLE: *Animal Caretaker Helper (m/f/d)*

GRADE: C-5048-03

WORK HOURS: 20 per week

REMARKS: Uncommon tour of duty to include but not limited to day and evening shifts, weekends and legal German holidays.

ORGANIZATION: 52 FSS/FSWS – Pet Lodge

LOCATION: Spangdahlem

On principle this position is also suitable for severely handicapped persons.

MAJOR DUTIES:

The purpose of this position is to help provide care to animals in the kennel service according to the directions of the owners and/or the supervisor/assistant manager and/or in the best interest of the well-being of the animal.

Responsible for the care of dogs, cats and other pets. Handles, feeds and waters pets. Exercises animals, letting each pet out of the kennel for at least 10 minutes three times a day; ensures dogs remain on the leash and animals are not in direct contact with other animals unless from the same family or permission is given from the owner for playtime in yards only. Bathes, dips, brushes and trims nails for animals in the kennel and grooming area; sometimes with assistance, as needed. Administers oral, topical and subcutaneous medications in accordance with written instructions as provided by the owner. Notes animal's health by evaluating basic health upon check-in and monitors the animal during its stay. Alerts supervisor/ manager or work leader to any changes in health, so adequate health care for pet can be obtained if needed. Maintains building areas in a clean, sanitary conditions to ensure no animal is subjected to an unhealthy environment. Cleans and sanitizes kennels. Washes pets belongings such as blankets, towels and toys. Performs outdoor maintenance to include clearing of the yard of animal feces, mowing grass, sweeping around doorways, picking up trash and clearing snow and ice from entrances. Empties and disposes of trash and recyclables, vacuums, dusts, mops and disinfects all required areas in the building. May pick up or deliver animals to Lodging, base areas and international airports, like Frankfurt, as scheduled. Maintains animal records and ensures appropriate records are completed upon check-in, lists

belongings of each pet and verifies special instructions of the owner. Schedules reservations and appointments. Fills out daily checklist for each pet. Receives and handles money for boarding, grooming, and transportation, etc. Checks pet out, ensuring all belongings are returned and relays any information regarding the pet's stay to the owner. Maintains record of supplies; reports needs to work leader or supervisor/manager.

Performs other job-related duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS/QUALIFIZIERUNGSANFORDERUNGEN:

Education and Training Level I – Lower secondary level school diploma

Proficiency Requirements:

- Excellent command of the English language, ELP Level 3 (passing score 85%) is required.
- Drivers license: Class B and must be able to drive a GOV.
- Must be able to deal with animals in a gentle, safe, reassuring manner. May be required to soothe and comfort nervous animals and owners. Must be able to maneuver and pick up animals in order to evaluate health and to groom them.
- Ability to use and operate small hand tools and lawnmower.

OTHER SIGNIFICANT REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be able to obtain ESTA/visa for TDY to CONUS or other countries requiring a VISA.
- Work may occasionally require travel away from the duty station.
- Irregular distribution of work hours, which include but are not limited to day and evening shifts, weekends, and holidays.
- Position requires frequent standing, bending, kneeling, stooping, and walking. Occasionally lifts up to 50 pounds. Incumbent will be required to work outdoors to walk dogs in all types of weather conditions (cold, rain, snow, etc.). Will also work indoors in ventilated, well-lit areas.
- May be exposed to strong odors, feces, urine, animal hair, blood, scratches, and bites during handling of animals. May also be exposed to parasites and contagious diseases.
- Might have to wear ear protection.
- Must complete all required training, like Customer Service Training, Fire & Safety Training etc..
