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***MAJOR DUTIES:***

**The primary purpose of this position is:** To serve as a professional specialist for engineering projects and site development / space utilization, providing difficult and complex facility project planning and programming for new construction, renovation, and improvement projects of real property facilities and infrastructure, including utility systems at Spangdahlem AB, the supporting Geographically Separated Units (GSUs) and the 52 Munitions Maintenance Group (52 MMG) supported Munitions Support Squadrons (MUNSS).

Provides complete facility planning and programming for assigned projects by establishing facility and infrastructure requirements critical for mission accomplishment; proposing the most effective and economical means of satisfying those requirements; identifying the year in which they will be required; and acquiring both the authority and resources necessary to meet facility requirements identified by the planning process.

Work with organizational managers and budget personnel to obtain and verify information used to justify and gain Congressional funding approval for proposed facility programs/projects.

Coordinates projects with other engineers in a variety of disciplines, architects, and planners as well as contracting officers, tenant organization representatives, and construction agents such as from private contracting companies, Army Corps of Engineer, and the AF Civil Engineer Center.

Keeps abreast of emerging technologies to ensure programmed development will not prematurely become obsolete.

Complies with health, safety, and environmental rules and procedures and performs work in a manner that enhances the safety of the work environment.

**Acceptable Creditable Experience:**

Salary Schedule C-6 through C-7a: Creditable experience must reflect the particular knowledge, skills, and abilities required for the position and must be in the same or in a similar line of work as the job for which considered. - Knowledge of facility systems, i.e. heating, ventilation, and air conditioning; lightning; plumbing; building envelope; and central utility systems.
- Must be able to obtain appropriate ESTA/Visa for travel to US or other countries.
- Work may occasionally require travel away from normal duty station on military or commercial aircraft.
- Inspections may be conducted in "hard-hat" areas and may require significant walking, bending, climbing, and stooping. Some worksites may involve exposure to environmental hazards.
- Air Force Institute of Technology (AFIT) Training 'WMGT 423 Project Programming Course' shall be completed within 12 months of occupying of this position.
- Certified Energy Manager (CEM) is desirable but not required for this position.
- LEED Accredited Professional certification is desirable but not required for this position.
- Ability to plan, lead, and record site/facility surveys and inspections.
